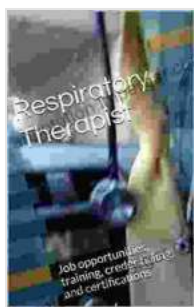

The CRT credential is the entry-level credential for respiratory therapists. The RRT credential is the advanced-level credential for respiratory therapists. The CPFT credential is for respiratory therapists who specialize in pulmonary function testing.

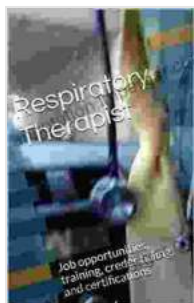
Salary and Career Outlook for Respiratory Therapists

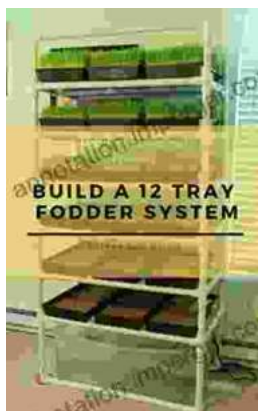
